4-H CAMP GUIDELINES

COLOR GROUP RESPONSIBILITIES:

When you register, you will receive a color. This means that you will be part of that Color Group. In your Color Group, you will meet for skits, sports and Color Group responsibilities. The Chaperones and Color Group Leaders are responsible for making sure that Color Group responsibilities are performed.

1. **Breakfast:** Come to the dining area (the slab) when called, usually about ½ hour before meals. Put WARM, SOAPY water in cans and wash the tables. Meet with the cooks, who will assign servers from your group. Set out supplies, the cooks will tell you what they are. After the meal, put away supplies and wash tables again.
2. **Lunch:** Same as Breakfast.
3. **Dinner:** Same as Breakfast.
4. **Equipment:** Make sure all recreation equipment is put away, usually in the corner by the kitchen under the bell, before Campfire.
5. **Campfire:** Gathering of firewood if needed, make sure the wood is stacked by the fire ring, the area is clear of debris and the fire ring is set up for the evening.
6. **Latrines:** Put toilet tissue in bathrooms, pick up any papers in bathrooms and hose off the floors.
7. **Free Time:** No chores on this day.

INSPECTIONS:

The purpose of Inspection is to keep the grounds and bunk areas clean and to provide a little competition between the boys and girls side of camp. Everyone must participate in keeping the camp clean. The Chaperones and Color Group Leaders are to help and supervise.

1. Beds are to be made.
2. Personal belongings should be put in an orderly fashion.
3. Laundry is to be put away unless wet.
4. GROUND ARE TO REMAIN IN A NATURAL CONDITION. If Mother Nature didn't put it there, then please place it in the trash can.
5. Inspection is to last no more than 30 minutes on each side of the bunk areas.
6. NO ONE is to be in the bunk areas during inspection.

CANDY SALES:

Every day during free time the candy shack will be open for 30 minutes. There will be a variety of candy and soda for campers to purchase.

FIRE DRILLS:

There will be at least one fire drill during the camp session. *If you hear the camp bell sound when it's not a normal mealtime (breakfast, lunch or dinner times), then it's a fire bell.* Please line up as you would for meals. Then a Chaperone will walk you out of camp in an orderly fashion.

PERSONAL TIME:

Everyday after you finish lunch there will be a half hour of "Personal Time" for the entire camp. You can rest on your bunks. You are not required to sleep during this time, but please be respectful of other campers or adults should they choose to take a nap. The pool and the craft area **will not** be open at this time.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Although it has not been necessary to send anyone home for behavioral reasons for a long, long time, the following is a list of behaviors that will not be tolerated:

1. Acting disrespectfully toward another person's property.
2. Acting disrespectfully toward adults in camp.
3. Possession of firecrackers, fire arms, or knives (including pocket-knives.
4. Leaving camp without permission.
5. Possession of alcohol, drugs (other than prescription drugs), tobacco, etc.
6. Possession of matches or lighters.
7. Unauthorized boys in the girl's area or girls in the boy's area.
8. Swimming at unauthorized times.
9. Hazing, pranks, threats, or harassment of other members (use of shaving cream, toothpaste, hair gel, lipstick or other substances on another member's person or property, etc.)
10. Writing on the walls or otherwise defacing the buildings at camp.

Infractions of the above rules may result in an immediate call to the parents to come to camp and pick up the camper.
