

MEMBERS CROSS CLUBBING CONTRACT

PURPOSE:

Not every club is able to offer all projects in which a member may be interested. Allowing members to participate in projects in other clubs helps meet the needs of the members. *If your primary club offers the project you are interested in, it is highly unlikely that you will get approval to participate in that same project with a different club, unless there is a special circumstance that the county office will approve.*

TERMS:

Primary Club: the club in which the member enrolls. The member agrees to follow the bylaws and deadlines established by the club.

Cross Club: the club that offers the project not offered by the primary club. The member must agree to follow the requirements of participation and completion set by the cross club project leader.

MEMBERS CROSS CLUBBING CONTRACT

There must be some coordination and agreement between the leaders of the primary club and the cross club.

By signing this agreement (contract) the community leaders, project leader(s), member, and member's parent agree to the following:

1. Acknowledgement of the reasons for the cross clubbing.
2. The member agrees to follow the bylaws of the primary club.
3. The member agrees to meet the requirements for participation and completion of both the primary club and the cross club project. If the member fails to meet all the requirements, they may not get approval from the project leader or the county office for the following year, or they may not be able to complete the current year in that project, pending circumstantial county office review.
4. The member must be enrolled in at least one project in the primary club (exception: if the member is enrolling in a county-wide project).
5. Project records will be checked and signed by the cross club project leader and turned in to the member to include in his/her Record Book. Record books will be turned in to the primary club by its due date (if required by the primary club).
6. Transportation to project meetings and activities is the responsibility of the member and his/her parent/guardian.
